STIPENDS: Registered educators will receive a **\$100 stipend for attending three hours** of the Virtual Summit. Roll will be called at the beginning and end of each session.

REGISTRATION: Registration fees are generously being covered by our coalition partners. Registered educators must indicate if they are using Statewide Learning Community (SLC) Grant Fund to cover registration fees or applying for a registration fee scholarship. Scholarships are only available for those educators ineligible for SLC grant funding.

Registration must be confirmed and approved.

All attendees must either have their registration fees paid through the Statewide Learning Community Grant Fund or a scholarship. **LOGIN INFORMATION:** This training will be online only using Zoom. Login information will be provided the week before the Summit. **RELICENSURE POINTS:** Those who attend three hours of the conference and complete the follow up assignment will receive 0.5 USBE credit. In order to receive USBE credit you must complete the additional assignment given at the conference. Details of that assignment and method of submission will be explained during the sessions.
